A special welcome to all of our new members as well as to all of our previous members! We'd like to share some T-bird information, discuss a few rules, explain what your dues provide, and outline the schedule of events for this ski season.

The Thunderbird Club is for members only. Your pass should be worn and be visible while you are in the club.

You are responsible for paying \$10.00 for any adult non-member, and \$5.00 for any child per visit (12 and under) who are your guests. The same non-member may only return as a guest once a month. Please go to the office to pay for and receive a guest pass. On any party day an extra \$10.00 / person must be paid to a Board Member for any guests (adult or child).

If you are interested in having a guest at Fun Weekend you must see a Board Member a week in advance to register the guest and pay a total of \$30 per adult (\$25.00 per child) per day on Fun Weekend (\$10.00 to Song Mt. and \$20.00 to the T-bird Club per adult and \$5.00 to Song Mt. and \$20.00 to the T-Bird Club per child).

Members are given a discount on tuning skis at Song's Alpine Edge in the main lodge.

Again this year we will have the opportunity for each member to race NASTAR at Song Mountain for the entire season as part of your dues. Watch for more details.

You are welcome to use the Keurig Coffee / Hot Chocolate / Tea maker. You will need to provide your own K cups.

- Please make room for everyone by sharing tables! A tablecloth on a table does not mean it is reserved.

- The instant hot water faucet for hot chocolate, tea, coffee, and soup is extremely hot. We request that only adults use it.

- Children should be supervised at all times.

- We recycle all cans and bottles. Please put them in the proper containers.

- Soda is provided each weekend. (You will need to provide your own cups).

- Beer, wine, and soda are provided at each party (You will need to bring your own cups and glasses).

- The grill on the deck is for everyone's use. Please help to keep it clean.

- Skis, poles, and snowboards should be kept in your locker or outside "on" the racks not upstairs or on the ground, please.

- There is no long-term parking by the doors. You may pull up briefly to unload your vehicle and then park in the lot.

- Event dates and news will be posted on our website ([songbird.com](http://songbird.com)) and on the bulletin board as you come up the stairs.

- Please volunteer to host a party and / or breakfast.
